As the new coffee season is fast approaching, our company has started early preparations at both our drying stations.

To increase our output, we are adding the number of drying beds at both our stations - now totaling 500 beds.

Accordingly, we have targeted to export 8 containers of specialty Guji natural coffees, as well as 50 containers of commercial coffees – mainly Guji G3, G4 & Sidamo G4– in 2022/2023 harvest season.



In addition, we have now started the application process for USDA Organic certification. We anticipate to finalize the process by December, 2022. In my opinion, providing certified coffees to our customers will show our commitment for quality and sustainability.

Furthermore, our company has completed its second payment to farmers who supplied coffee to our stations. We believe that this payment is very important for farmers because it is a show of appreciation for the quality of coffee they produced, but most importantly it is means to show good gesture by supporting farmers during the current non-harvesting period.



All in all, our company is striving to provide value not only to our customers, but also to farmers who supply coffee to our stations. We are expecting for the new coffee season to be exceptional both in terms of harvest and export due to the fact that most coffee growing regions are expecting massive and unprecedented coffee harvest in 2022/2023 harvest season. I certainly hope that this massive harvest will keep coffee cherry prices at a reasonable range and allow Ethiopian coffee to be competitive on the world market.
